## **Locking Mailboxes**


Two years ago, the HOA installed new mailboxes. Due to recent incidents where individuals have come into the neighborhood openly taking mail, several residents have installed locking mailboxes approved by the HOA. The plan is when the financial reserve is available (no earlier than 2026), those who have installed a locking mailbox will be reimbursed by the HOA. #### **Dog Waste Stations**

Dogs are great companions and friends to the owners but they can not pick up their own waste. So the HOA board installed a dog waste station at each gate to help you. Each station has disposable bags and a receptacle for bag collection. They are regularly maintained but if you noticed any needs, please let Encore know.

#### Installation of Speed Cushion

There is a plan to install speed humps in the neighborhood as a secondary step to increase traffic calming. We have already taken the first step of traffic calming by improving speed limit sign visibility.
